## **TUITION ASSISTANCE:**

We serve any person wishing to learn and those in need of care regardless of financial circumstance. We train people of all traditions to develop capacity, tenderness, and the passion of service. We keep tuition fees as low as possible while also recognizing the necessity for long term viability of this school. The exchange for service is essential. We remain present to the economic challenges of our lives.

<u>Payment Plans</u>: Payment plans are made individually between the participant and staff of the UH. Rather than discounts in tuition, many current students pay for tuition with regular, interest-free monthly or quarterly payments. (This is now possible to do on-line and can also be set up to work directly through paypal.) There are some students who participate in many workshops throughout the year and negotiate a monthly payment to include tuition for all events, paid throughout the year.

<u>Tuition Assistance</u>: Tuition assistance is allocated individually between the participant and staff of the UH. We provide assistance on an as-needed basis. We recognize times of crisis when there is no extra income. We recognize the demands of viability in an economy with ever-increasing rates of health care and unemployment. We recognize the limits of people on fixed-income, whether because of age, raising children, illness, disability, etc. Our politic with money is fundamental to the life of the Tradition. This Tradition rises from the deep springs of life.
